Admission

The academic year starts from June to April. Applications for admission should be made in the prescribed form available in the school office. The parent along with the child will have to appear for an interactive session (not an interview) with the Principal, after which the Admission will be confirmed. An Admission Card will be issued after the payment of Registration fee and Term fees.

Students who seek admission from other schools are admitted on the basis of their Transfer Certificate.

Curriculum

The School offers quality education in accordance with the syllabi prepared by the Tamilnadu Government from Class I to Class X and for Std XI and XII, the Tamilnadu State Board for Higher Secondary Classes. For LKG and UKG, the text book designed by CBSE, based on CCE is used. The medium of instruction is English along with Tamil as second language.

Computer Science is taught from class I to Std XII. Multimedia is used for teaching and learning. A variety of play materials are used for K.G and Primary Classes.

Special coaching classes are offered for Std X, XI and XII students, to face the Board Exams confidently.

Co-Curricular Activities

- Training in literary competitions like Debate, Elocution, Dramatics, Quiz etc.
- ♥ Coaching in extra-curricular activities like Music, Dance, Karate, Silambam, Tennis, Volley ball and Throw ball.

It is compulsory for a child to register his/her name atleast in any of these clubs.

The spacious and well-ventilated Physics, Chemistry and Biology labs, fully furnished with the necessary instruments and accessories, ensure that the practical understanding of the subject is comprehensive and complete.

The library houses reference books, fiction and several graded English books and reading cards for young readers. Lot of thrust is given to English reading and comprehension, with the introduction of compulsory Library period per week.

The Audio-visual Room with its multimedia facility, acts as a catalyst in imparting education.

Play School

A well-resourced playschool for children who have completed 2 years of age, with the latest play equipments, indoor and outdoor play areas. Well-trained staff with love and compassion, give individual attention to the safety and well-being of the tiny-toys and groom them through the play-way (Montessori) method of learning. The curriculum is specially designed to captivate the young minds, with a variety of actions songs, rhymes, scrap book work, clay modeling and nature walk. (Timings: 9.00 am. to 12.00 noon).

Daily Report & SMS Alerts

For clarity of communication, a Daily Report Register is maintained by the class Teachers. This keeps tab of the student's regularity of school, completion of assignments, bringing the materials etc. A parent gets a clear picture of their ward's academic and behavioural performance, through the sms alerts from the school.

<u>100th Day</u>

The 100th Day celebration is a unique facet of the Violet School. The number 100 denotes fullness or completeness - a 100 runs in cricket, 100 years, 100 marks and so on... the 100th Day of the Academic year is the day marked for showcasing the talent and potential of the Child. Children are encouraged to recite 100 couplets from Thirukural, 100 Scientists, 100 Countries and capitals, to do 100 jumps on a skipping rope, or to make 100 articles from waste products etc.





Field Trips

Field trips are an integral parts of learning. Children are taken to various places such as industries, factories, libraries, supermarket, museum, zoo, parks, petrol bunk, post office, aquarium and religious places. The children are to submit a "Report" of their Educational Field Trip, and thus they are trained in observation, recording of details and presentation. Talks and group discussions are also initiated in the class, to guide them into further research and scientific approach of problem solving.

Culturals

The Children's Day every year brings the much awaited Intra-house cultural. Talent Search is on as the School senate organizes the events such as Handwriting, Essay-Writing, Drawing & Painting, Solo-Singing, Dancing, Quiz, Dumb Charades, ADZAP, Shipwreck, One minute to fame, Rangoli, Wealth from waste, Bouquet making and so on.

Violets boast of Volley ball and Kho-Kho courts, a spacious ground and a trendy cricket pitch. Violetans are given coaching for Athletics, Kho-Kho, Volley ball and cricket. The Violet Interschool Kho-Kho tournament will be hosted and organized by the School and the Violet Trophy goes for the School with the maximum winners.
